**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

Please provide an email address, final confirmation of your entry and a judging schedule will be sent to the email address provided—you will NOT receive a confirmation via US mail. If you do not provide an email address, your confirmation of entry and judging schedule will be mailed to the address provided on your entry form. I send initial confirmations within 48 hours of receiving entries: final confirmations go out shortly after closing. **If you have not received a copy of your confirmations, contact me: and PLEASE make sure my email address is on your approved senders list.**

**From Chapter 1, Section 20:** Move-Up will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date April 29<sup>th</sup>.2026. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 P.M., May 11<sup>th</sup>. 2026.. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

**From Chapter 1, Section 21:** After the close of entries, a dog which has been entered in a class for which it is not eligible for, due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the correct class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. (ie, Master to Excellent, or Novice A to Novice B, or any other class. Moves between regular

and preferred divisions are not permitted after the trial closing date.)

Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.

After the closing date, KCA is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after closing. A maximum of 25 dogs per day will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to March 25<sup>th</sup>, at 12:00 P.M. Any entries withdrawn prior to SUNDAY, April 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 P.M., will be replaced by a wait list entry when available. A full refund will be given to withdrawn entries when wait listed entries are available to replace the pulled entry. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by April 12<sup>th</sup>, at 6 P.M. will receive a full refund.

An Email with a link to worker sign up will be sent after closing.

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warmup area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog. Electronic timing devices may be used.

## ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

Directions to Royal Canin Ring at Roberts Centre

123 Gano Road, Wilmington, OH 45177, 800-654-7038

Gano Road is immediately West of the I-71 interchange.

The Roberts Centre/Royal Canin Ring/Holiday Inn is located at I-71, Exit 50 (US Rt 68) and is visible from the highway.

Directions From The North: Take I-71 South, take Exit 50 (US Rt 68). Turn right (West) on Rt 68, then Right onto Gano Rd. Roberts Centre/Royal Canin Ring will be on your left.

Directions From The South: Take I-71 North, take Exit 50 (US Rt 68). Turn left (West) on Rt 68, then Right onto Gano Rd. Roberts Centre/Royal Canin Ring will be on your left.

Directions from the West: Take I-75 to US 35 East, Take US Rt 68 South toward Wilmington, Turn left onto Gano Rd. Roberts Centre/Royal Canin Ring will be on your left.

## MEASURING

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured / wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores. ***There will be a VMO at the trial. Are You Entered In The Right Height?***

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Keeshond Club of America, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Keeshond Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Keeshond Club of America, Inc or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

### ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all Keeshonds 15 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Canine Partners are allowed entry into this set of trials.

## **REFUNDS**

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in AKC Agility Trials. Bitches in heat may be withdrawn and the entry fee (less \$5.00 per run) returned upon request of the competitor. Requests must be made 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial and must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement.

## **RINGSIDE**

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**DOGS MUST BE ON LEAD AT ALL TIMES OR CONFINED TO A CRATE OR EXERCISE PEN EXCEPT WHEN COMPETING OR WITHIN THE WARM-UP RING AREA.**

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
