At independent specialties Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may compete.

Stud Dog Class Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. The class will be judged based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee, plus the Additional Class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class.

Brood Bitch Class Same as the Stud Dog class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class – Two Keeshonden with at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated as “Brace #1”, “Brace #2”, etc. The Brace as a unit shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee, or the Additional Class fee if both dogs are entered in another class.

3 Point Major Reserve

Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex total at least twice the number required for a five-point major in the region in which the event is held.

NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The KCA will hold a NOHS event at both the Regional and National specialties on **Wednesday & Friday**. Please check the box on your dog's entry form if you are eligible and wish to enter this special **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** competition.

There is no additional fee for this competition.

Online entrants – Please check the Owner Handler Eligible box, or write 'NOHS' in the Additional Classes box.

Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

GENERAL OBEDIENCE & RALLY ENTRY RULES & INFORMATION

- The term "dog" refers to either dog or bitch in both Obedience and Rally.
- Qualifying scores are required for all trophies and rosettes in the regular classes. Qualifying scores are not required for prizes in Non-Regular classes.
- Non-Regular classes are not eligible for the Special Obedience Trial trophies, nor will qualifying scores be awarded AKC legs or points towards Obedience Trial Championships.
- OBEDIENCE & RALLY MOVE-UPS WILL BE ACCEPTED ACCORDING TO AKC REGULATIONS.
- **AKC Refund Policy - Withdrawals** after the event's closing date and time due to a change of judge must receive a full refund (no fee is paid to the AKC). Females in season must be fully refunded if withdrawn after closing and no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. The Club may retain a processing fee as specified in the premium list.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH PUPPY COMPETITION

Entry fee \$20.00 The KCA will offer Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competitions at both the Regional and National specialties on **Wednesday & Friday**. Entry can be made using the regular AKC Entry Form. Please designate "4-6 Month" in the Dog Show Class box. The AKC Litter Registration number can be used. The 4-6 Month Puppy Class will NOT be divided by sex. A Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex will be selected from the entrants in the class. *Please Note: Per AKC Rules, Professional Handlers and their assistants may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" and will not compete for awards. Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or their assistants may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Minors under 18 with amateur status who reside with professional handlers or their assistants may personally exhibit dogs and compete for awards in this competition.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Entry Fee \$10.00 – FREE as an Additional Class

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 First Place wins in an Open class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the AKC National Championship competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry on the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Notice: Juniors who win a third Novice Class with competition present may transfer their entry into the Open Class provided that the transfer is made at the Show Secretary's desk at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

The futurity stakes will be open only to **puppies from litters nominated** and bred by members of the Keeshond Club of America and members of its affiliated clubs, co-breeders included. Entrants need not be owned by the breeder. All Futurity entrants must also be entered in a regular class at the National Specialty Show. Indicate your Futurity class in the “Additional Class” field on the entry form. An additional fee of \$6.00 is required.

CLASSES- Four classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Puppy	July 15 th 2025 to October 14 th 2025
Junior	April 15 th 2025 to July 14 th 2025
Intermediate	January 15 th 2025 to April 14 th 2025

An additional fee of \$6.00 is required.

The theme will be the “Acadogmy Awards,” so bring your true Hollywood glamour with you! Sequins, Beads, Pearls with evening or cocktail dresses for the ladies and tuxes or suits for the men are suggested.

THE TOP KEESHOND EVENT is to provide single competition for the top-ranking Keeshonden during the past year judged by three unannounced JUDGES. It is an opportunity to showcase and appreciate some of the best dogs the Keeshond fancy has to offer. It is intended to be both educational and enjoyable, serving to advance knowledge and appreciation of the breed. To be invited to participate in the Top Keeshond Event, a dog must be ranked in the top 25 Keeshonden for the previous calendar year. In addition, if the top 5 ranking bitches do not appear on the above stated list, they will also be deemed eligible to compete. Tabulations for eligibility will be based on Keeshonden defeated as a result of Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex wins as noted on the KCA Website Rankings from January 1 through December 31 of the year proceeding the competition. At this year’s Top Keeshond Event we will be awarding a winning Best of Breed award and a winning Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed award.

FORMAT FOR THE 2026 TOP KEESHOND EVENT

Each entrant will be given specific ring time. Entrants will be judged both as a group and then also in groups of three, allowing opportunity for each of the three judges to individually perform a hands-on exam, followed by each entrant being judged on movement by all three judges simultaneously. The evening showcase grand finale will feature the introduction of each of the TKE entrants as they circle the ring to their chosen musical selection, followed by the announcement of the Top Keeshond Events Winners.

MOST VERSATILE KEESHOND

The Most Versatile Keeshond will be determined for Keeshonden that enter and compete in at least 2 of 5 National events: Conformation, Obedience, Rally, Fast CAT and Agility. Points are awarded for participation and placement or score in each event at both the Regional Specialty and the National Specialty. There is no fee for the competition, but advanced registration is required. A registration form will be available on the 2026 KCA National website.

Point values will be assigned to entrants in competition as follows:

Conformation (2 shows):

1pt – Participation

2 pt – Class placement (must be competition i.e. 5 dogs for a 4th class placement to be awarded)

Points. Only regular and Veterans classes count. (Sweeps, Futurity, Stud dog, Brood bitch, Brace are not eligible for VK points)

3 pt – Made the cut in the BOB ring

4 pt – BOB, BOS, Select, AOM, W, RW

Obedience (2 trials):

1 pt – Participation or Beginner Novice or Veterans scoring below 170.

2 pt – Qualifying Novice, Preferred Novice, Graduate Novice score, or Veterans with a score of at least 170

3 pt – Qualifying Open, Preferred Open, or Graduate Open score

4 pt – Qualifying Utility or Preferred Utility score

Rally (2 trials):

1 pt – Participation

2 pt – Qualifying Novice/Intermediate score

3 pt – Qualifying Advanced score

4 pt – Qualifying Excellent/Master/Choice score (maximum of 4 pts. per trial)

Fast CAT (4 trials)

1 pt – Participation (1 pt. per run, maximum of 4 pts.)

2 pt – Qualifying runs (2 pts. Per qualifying run, maximum of 8 pts.)

Agility (1 trial) (Preferred classes scored the same as regular classes):

2 pts. participation in at least two classes (or 1 pt. per class with a maximum of 2 points with no Qs)

4 pts. Q in 2 Novice classes (Std./JWW/FAST) or T2B (2 pts. per class, maximum of 4)

6 pts. Q in 2 Open classes (Std./JWW/FAST and Masters FAST) (3 pts. per class, maximum of 6)

8 pts. Q in 2 Master/Excellent classes (Std./JWW) (4 points per class, maximum of 8)

Agility examples – 1. Fluffy Qs in Masters Std. and JWW, Masters FAST and NQs in T2B - earns the maximum 8 points

2. Casey Qs in Open FAST, Open Std, and T2B and NQs in Open JWW - earns the maximum 6 points

3. Speedy Qs in Novice Std. and Novice FAST and T2B, and NQs in Novice JWW - earns the maximum 4 points

Dogs mixing levels cannot earn more than half the maximum per level. i.e. Q in Novice Std. and JWW and Open FAST earns 5 points

MOST VERSATILE KEESHOND, cont'd

Bonus: 1 Point if a dog competes in all FIVE venues (not necessarily in both shows/trials).

Dogs that make a cut or earn placements and awards in conformation competition will be awarded 2, 3 or 4 points as applicable to the award, but do not receive the participation point as well. Dogs who make multiple cuts will receive the same three points as dogs that make one cut.

Dogs excused from the conformation ring shall still be awarded a point for participation. Dogs receiving qualifying scores in companion/performance events will be awarded 2, 3 or 4 points as appropriate for their class, but do not receive the participation point. The participation point in companion/performance events is awarded only if the dog competes but does not qualify in the event. **Dogs competing in multiple classes at the same venue will be credited with the highest qualification class.** The maximum point value in each venue is 4 points per show/trial for conformation, obedience, and rally. There are 4 Fast CAT trials, so to weigh the venue equally 2 points are awarded for qualifying run at each trial. Because there is only one agility trial, points are awarded so venues are weighed equally. A dog competing in all events, at the highest levels, at both Specialties could earn a maximum of 41 points.

In the event of a tie, event scores shall be used to break the tie, with preference given to the higher level or faster time. The dog with the highest total score will receive the award. The official catalog markings taken from the judges' books for each event shall be used to determine eligibility, participation, placements, and official scores. The trophy will be awarded at the Annual KCA banquet.

There is no fee for the competition, but advance registration is required. Please complete the form below to help our statistician keep track of points. (This competition is separate from the parent club KCA Versatile Keeshond titles.) Schedule is subject to change.

HOLIDAY INN ROBERTS CENTRE RULES AND REGULATIONS

All dogs left unattended in hotel guest rooms must be crated.

Group must provide sheets of plastic to place under the crates. Up to four dogs will be permitted per room. Housekeepers will NOT have to service rooms in which dogs are loose and unattended. Moreover, they will be required to report this rule violation to hotel management. A pet fee of \$75.00+tax will be charged for each room in which a dog is housed per stay. Rooms found to house a **dog/animal that is not secured in a crate will be charged a higher pet fee of \$250+tax**. Individual room occupants will be assessed for any damage or destruction to their room – including but not limited to: sheets, towels, flooring, furniture, carpet, etc.

Dogs will be bathed in designated areas for dog washing. There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms and no hotel towels will be used for this purpose. Rooms where evidence of dog grooming in the restrooms is found will be assessed an excessive room cleaning fee.

Group will assign a liaison to meet daily with the Head of Housekeeping and hotel management to assure that all its members are complying with hotel rules. Any offenders will be asked to leave hotel immediately.

Dogs will not be permitted in any of the hotel recreation areas, including the swimming pools, and any other areas to be stipulated as “non-dog” locations. Dogs will not be permitted in food and beverage outlets, apart from those assisting the disabled. Pick up and removal of waste will be the responsibility of each dog owner/handler.

If excessive amounts of waste/urine are found to have not been removed/cleaned, an excessive clean-up fee may be added to the final bill.

Convention Center doors must be closed during event hours for safety of the dogs.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. This includes properly disposing of waste, trash, etc and using designated relief areas and the public x-pen area on the south side of the Property, clearly marked with signage. Designated stations throughout the facility should be used appropriately (i.e. watering station should not be used for waste or other materials.)

Exclusivity. No booths, signage, products, activities or communications of any kind that represents pet food or litter products companies other than Royal Canin (“Non- Royal Canin Products”) shall be permitted in the Centre or on Royal Canin Ring property (“Property”) during the term of this Agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Event participants may feed their animals the products of their choice and may wear clothing advertising Non- Royal Canin Products. Event participants may not, however, provide any advertising materials (e.g. brochures, signage_ in support of Non- Royal Canin Products to other participants while at the Centre.

Royal Canin Ring does not permit overnight crating of animals. If a pre-arranged exception of overnight crating in Royal Canin Ring is allowed, the Club must work with Royal Canin Ring to provide security (10p.m. – 6a.m. the next morning). 30 days’ notice to Royal Canin Ring is required in order to schedule security. Security is charged as a flat rate of \$50.00 per man hour (4-hour minimum).

No exercise pens are permitted around the front of Royal Canin Ring or the Holiday Inn Hotel and exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged. All dogs are required to be on-leash at Royal Canin Ring and the Holiday Inn Hotel at all times (except when crated or as required to be judged). Exhibitors accept personal liability with respect to any claim made in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dog/s or dogs in their possession.

Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS** make fees payable in **U.S. FUNDS. NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

RETURNED CHECKS will be charged a \$35.00 collection fee. The returned check must be paid with CASH at the Show Secretary's desk or office BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring. **No post-dated checks** will be accepted. **TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**
